## Grapevine workshop

As the District 22 Grapevine Chair I attended the workshop which was put on by Area 36 & District 15. The keynote speaker was Chris C. publisher of the Grapevine who joined us electronically from New York. I will have his power point uploaded to the District 22 website...key take aways were Grapevine is projected to lose money in 2024, breakeven in 2025, and projected to turn a profit in 2026. This is largely due to the best thing that has happened to Grapevine in a long time and that is the NEW Grapevine App which is available. There are currently 26,623 downloads, and the app offers a FREE podcast which is currently in the top 1.5% of ALL podcasts, with 775,000 downloads, nationwide and growing.

Chris commented that the best way for this growth to continue is via "word of mouth" ...so download the app, listen to the FREE podcast, and spread the word!
