different ways. But then he said, "for EVERY interruption there is an Invitation", to
participate in creation (theological terms), in other words to make the world a
better place (laymen's terms). Finally he said, "for every invitation there is ALWAYS
a Resistance"...and that resistance comes in the form of what does this mean to
me & how does this affect my life?

I believe a big part of Recovery/AA is learning to overcome this Resistance, the ability to say YES, even though it may be inconvenient! The willingness to try and make the world a better place. I know that this newsletter is one of those interruptions in my life, and I have obviously been resistant to getting a 3rd quarter newsletter out in a timely fashion.

With that said, if you are one of the 8-10 people that may be reading this perhaps this is your **INERRUPTION/INVITAION/RESISATNCE**...DISTRICT 22 could use your help. Even if you don't accept this invitation, just know there will be plenty more interruptions/opportunities to make the world a little better place.
